Stowaway Labrador Retrievers

In the mid-1970s' I moved away from home and had to leave the family dog behind. I immediately adopted a black mixed breed dog, Kanoe. About the same time my niece Dee Dee Anderson adopted a very large St Bernard / Huskie, Taku. It was decided that Dee Dee and I should go to a local Parks and Recreation obedience class in Redwood City, as Taku was rapidly growing larger than Dee Dee! Our instructor encouraged us to join the "All American" dog club for mixed breeds. Dee Dee earned a CDX with Taku and I earned a UD with Kanoe. We never looked back...

I began earning AKC obedience titles on friends' purebred dogs. When the time came to get my own purebred dog, I was drawn to Labradors and Dee Dee was drawn to Goldens. We began attending AKC field trials, obedience trials and breed shows. I admired the courage and trainability of the field trail labs, but (coming from horses), preferred the structure of the breed labs. By this time I had spent many pheasant hunting seasons with a friend's German Shorthair. So I decided to look for a lab from "working" show lines.

In 1980 I attended the Sacramento KC dog show and obedience trial. Watching the lab breed ring, I was struck by the most beautiful young black bitch with the most soulful eyes and gorgeous length of neck. She was to become AM Can CH Sailin's Mizzen UD Can CD. After the show, Beth Davis (Sailin) spent a good hour visiting with me and invited me to meet the rest for her dogs. We swam the dogs, threw marks and I looked at multiple

photos for her show dogs hunting. That day Mizzen came home with me and was to become my foundation.

I picked my kennel name, Stowaway, after a couple of co breedings with Beth. I was to receive a puppy back from a breeding by my Rocky (Can CH Sailin Don't Rock the Boat CDX JH WC, Can CD) and was hoping for a black girl. Only yellows were born, so I mention this little yellow girl was like a "stowaway" in my van full of black dogs! She became Sailin's Stowaway UD JH WC, Can CDX WC. Multi generations of working show lines have been produced. Currently co owning a couple of nice working dogs (Evan and Tyler) with Shirley Trotter.

I joined GGLRC in 1982. I have met my best friends through dogs. Over the years I have held board member and president positions, along with many other duties. This club has so much to offer. I encourage you to volunteer. Do it for yourself and your Labradors!
