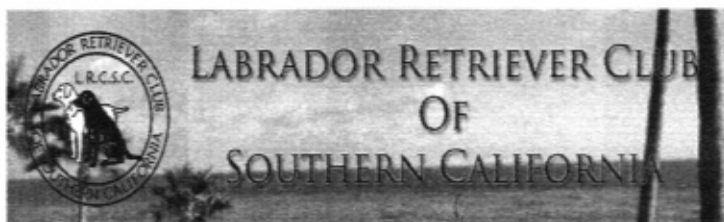
**WITH DEEPEST SYMPATHY –
