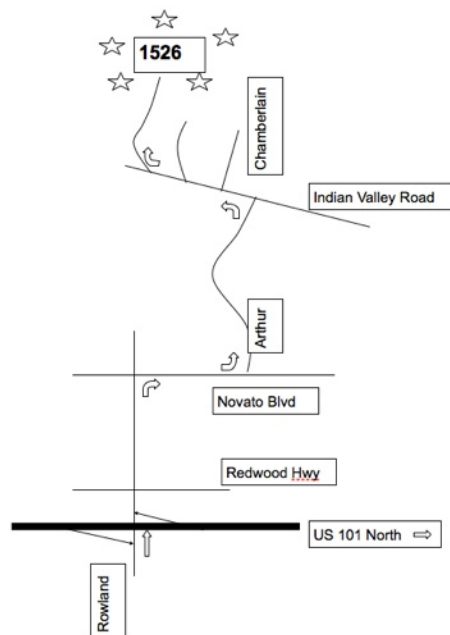

Golden Gate Labrador Retriever Club 2011 Specialty Show, Sweepstakes, Obedience Trial and Rally Trial

SHOW REPORT

This year we were greeted by 5 days of beautiful weather for our two specialties and three supported entries. Also this year our hosting Clubs, Skyline Dog Fanciers of San Mateo County and Del Valle Dog Club of Livermore, allowed us to remain in the same ring out in The Orchard, on the Alameda County Fairgrounds, for all five days which is a real convenience for us hosting the shows and our exhibitors alike.

No event of this size happens due to the work of one person. I would like to thank *everyone* who contributed to our week of shows no matter small the job.

Throughout the year *Janet Bennett* collects likely items for our Specialty Raffle. The proceeds of this raffle help to offset the expenses of our specialty, particularly the judges' travel expenses.

A new idea for offsetting the costs associated with our specialty shows was explored this year by *Tabby Walker*. She launched a 50/50 Raffle where ticket purchasers have the chance to collect ½ the "take" on the ticket sales with the balance going to our Club. Look for her to expand on this idea at future specialties.

Lorrie Bellows, a non Club member, acts as our Judges Liaison. Her job consists of contacting our prospective judges to see if they will accept our invitation to judge, guides them through the AKC judges' application if necessary for our foreign judges, making travel arrangements, and hosting them while they are here. Club member, *Jan Hepper*, acts as a hostess for our judges once they arrive in the Bay Area.

Jennifer Kelly does double duty as Catalog Advertising Chair and Trophy Donation Solicitation. Both these jobs help tremendously in offsetting the cost of our shows. Along with Jennifer, *Ruth Hertzog* coordinates the Trophy Donation Solicitation and follows up on donations to make sure they are given to our treasurer. Trophies are one of the two largest expenses we have in connection to our show (the other is judges travel).

New to the Show Committee was *Carol White*, who ordered our trophies and then had the monumental job of unpacking them, labeling them and repacking them for transport to the show. It is a HUGE job given the number of trophies we offer. Our specialty is one of the few in the US to award trophies to 1st through 4th place in every class!

Becoming active once again in our Club is *Vicki Blodgett*, past president of this Club. This year Vicki unpacked trophies and made sure the appropriate trophies were on hand for our hard working ring stewards over the two days of our specialty.

Another former member who has continued her association with our Club is *Chris Hempel*. She along with her partner, *Maureen Dagnan*, provide the scrumptious goodies and coffee available in the mornings of our specialties. Since not everyone can win a ribbon, hospitality leaves a wonderful impression on our exhibitors.

Ann Perry provides the Judges Lunches for our judges, ring stewards, and other helpers for our Club. Again, our hospitality is a hallmark of our specialty.

The day of the stand alone specialty, *Vivian Poole* mans the Catalog Sales table. Not only does she sell catalogs, she is the face of the Club for spectators coming to our show looking for information. Vivian also helps cut our show expenses by laundering the beautiful table cloths we have to dress up our rings. If you think that's a trivial job try wrestling with an 8 foot table cloth on your ironing board...

A big behind the scenes job that most people don't know about is our Health Clinic Coordinator, who is *Georgia Baba*. The AKC has declared that in order to hold a specialty show, the show giving club host some sort of health screening clinic each year. In the past we have offered a 20/20 Optigen Eye Screening clinic but in the last couple years we have employed the services of Dr Keinle, veterinary cardiologist, to screen canine hearts for evidence of heritable disease. Georgia books appointments in advance of the specialty and helps with the actual



running of the clinic during the specialty. This means she sacrifices the opportunity to handle her own dogs in the ring or even watch them being presented by someone else!

This year we had the good fortune to have offered to us the major tenting of Stages Unlimited from **Katy Bazurto**. While the Club as several "pop-ups" to use in protecting our different tables, Katy provided two 15x15' heavy duty tents to cover our Raffle and Trophy tables. Thank goodness we didn't have to protect things from rain, but having good cover for our valuables is a real luxury.

We had a change to our Obedience and Rally Trials this year in that **Melinda Grosch** took over as Chair for these two events within our Specialty. She

rounded up ring stewards and equipment, and organized the trials the day of our shows.

She took over from long standing Obedience and Rally Chairs, **Marion and Michael Bashista**, who this year ring stewarded and exhibited their own dog. Also donating their time in ring stewarding were **Marilou Garfinkle, Connie Holm, Chris Hyde, Teresa Russell, and Sharon Ventura**. In addition to ring stewarding, Sharon helped me with show set up on the Wednesday before the show and throughout the days of the shows with whatever I needed.

Our stand alone specialty on Saturday always concludes with our fabulous Wine & Cheese Reception. This gathering at the end of our specialty gives exhibitors and judges the time to socialize in an



atmosphere of relaxation and refreshment. As in the past couple of years, this signature event was hosted by **Marilou and Allen Garfinkle**. The food and wine are always superb, and presentation as elegant as it gets at a dog show.

And last, I would also like to thank all the **Club Members** and **Exhibitors** who donated to the Trophy Fund. I realize dog shows are not the focus of the majority of dog owners these days and I appreciate that even if they don't participate, Club Members donated in sponsoring trophies to make our Specialty Show "special."

Now that the 2011 Specialty Shows, Sweepstakes, Obedience Trial and Rally Trial have been put to bed, so to speak, I am looking forward to the 2012 events. We are planning to offer Junior Showmanship at our stand alone show next year so if you know of any aspiring young handlers, please bookmark our dates. The dates of our shows for next year are—Thursday, Oct 18; Friday, October 19 GGLRC Specialty within the Skyline DF of San Mateo Co show; Saturday, October 20 GGLRC Specialty Show; Sunday, October 21; and Monday, October 22, 2012.

I hope I have not forgotten anyone in my mentioning of names. Please know that I appreciate EVERYONE who helps.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:
